My targets for this unit

Working towards Age Related Outcomes

- Pupils will recognise a crib and know that St Francis created a real life crib in a cave AT1
- Pupils will be able to recognise that Christians throughout the world prepare in special ways to celebrate the birth of Jesus and be able to state one custom AT1
- Pupils will be able to recognise some of the words connected with Advent including: Advent, Crib, Wreath, Santon. AT1
- Pupils will be able to talk about how they and others prepare during advent AT2

Age Related Outcomes

- Pupils will be able to retell the origins of the Christmas Crib AT1
- Pupils will be able to describe some symbols and customs used throughout the world to prepare for Advent AT1
- Pupils will be able to use the words advent, preparation, Crib, Santon, Wreath, and explain their meaning (AT1ii)
- Pupils will be able to say why Christians prepare during Advent AT1
- Pupils will be able to ask questions about how they and others prepare to celebrate Christmas and recognise that some of these questions are difficult to answer AT2

Working in greater depth

- Pupils will be able to explain the meaning the Crib and why St Francis created it.AT1
- Pupils will be able to talk about the meaning of at least one other custom from around the world AT1
- Ask relevant questions about why people bring their cribs for blessing by the Pope AT2.
- After reading the Pope's prayer of Blessing ask if Christians really do try to live out the words AT2
