<p>LKS2 1.1.1 Get Up! 5 x 15-minute sessions over 5 days</p> <p>LKS2 1.1.2 The Sacraments</p> <p>Building on the reflective sessions on the account of the raising of Jairus' daughter, this session unpacks the Sacraments of Baptism and Reconciliation.</p>	<p>LKS2 2.1.1 Jesus, My Friend 4 X 15-minute sessions over 4 days.</p> <p>LKS2 2.2.1 Family, Friends and Others</p> <p>This session will help children to identify more complex relationships in their lives, including family, friends and other people, and explore how to relate to people within these different relationships.</p>	<p>LKS2 2.2.2 When Things Feel Bad</p> <p>In this session, children will learn how to recognise bullying and abuse (including physical bullying and emotional bullying online). Children will consider how bullying affects people, and what strategies can be employed to resist pressure and practise resilience.</p>	<p>LKS2 2.3.1 Sharing Online</p> <p>This session focuses on how quickly things can be shared around the world online, including photos, passwords and other personal information. Children will discuss how this can be damaging and/or dangerous, and will learn steps to keep themselves safe.</p>	<p>LKS2 2.3.2 Chatting Online</p> <p>This session focuses particularly on chatting and cyberbullying; it helps children to know how they can report and get help if they encounter inappropriate messages or material.</p>	<p>LKS2 2.4.1 Safe In My Body</p> <p>Children will be introduced to the term 'abuse' and discuss different kinds of abuse, including sexual abuse, here referred to as '*abuse of private parts'. Children will be asked to think of trusted adults that they can talk to about any issues they may face.</p>
