<p><u>KS1 1.1.1 Let the Children Come</u> 5 x 10-minute sessions over 5 days</p> <p><u>KS1 2.1.1 God Loves You</u></p> <p>This session tells the story of 'The Prodigal Son' to show that God loves us, and nothing we can do will stop Him from loving us.</p>	<p><u>KS1 2.2.1 Special People</u></p> <p>This session will help children to identify the 'special people' in their lives and what makes them special. Children will understand the importance of the nuclear and wider family, and of being close to and trusting their special people, especially their parents.</p>	<p><u>KS1 2.2.2 Treat Others Well...</u></p> <p>This session investigates how their behaviour can affect other people. Children will interact with a film to help them to identify appropriate and inappropriate behaviours and the effects that they can have.</p>	<p><u>KS1 2.2.3 ...And Say Sorry</u></p> <p>Children will watch interviews with the characters in film from the last session to see how they felt about what had happened, and the significance of saying sorry.</p>	<p><u>KS1 2.4.1 Good and Bad Secrets</u></p> <p>In this session, children will learn the difference between good secrets that are safe to keep, and bad secrets that are unsafe to keep. They will help Super Susie to decide whether some secrets she is asked to keep are good or bad, and what to do about it.</p>	<p><u>KS1 2.4.2 Physical Contact</u></p> <p>This session incorporates the PANTS resources from the NSPCC that teach children: Privates are private. Always remember your body belongs to you. No means no. Talk about secrets that upset you. Speak up, someone can help.</p>
