<p>KS1 1.1.1 Let the Children Come 5 x 10-minute sessions over 5 days</p> <p>Over five days, children will hear and experience the Gospel story of Jesus welcoming little children to Him in spite of others telling them to stay away.</p>	<p>KS1 1.2.1 I Am Unique</p> <p>This session builds on they're all special because they are made and loved by God. Children will be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between fictional people and each other as things that make us unique and special.</p>	<p>KS1 1.2.2 Girls and Boys</p> <p>This session is all about celebrating our God-given bodies and the things they enable us to do! In an age-appropriate way, children will be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between girls and boys on physical, emotional and spiritual levels.</p>	<p>KS1 1.2.3 Clean and Healthy (My Body)</p> <p>Building from the last session where children learned that our bodies are good, this session teaches children how to take care of their bodies. Children will meet Super Susie and help teach her how to take care of herself.</p>	<p>KS1 1.3.1 Feelings, Likes and Dislikes</p> <p>In this session, children will watch a video where two presenters, Zoe and Joey, are trying to understand the feelings inside their heads. Children will realise that we all have different feelings at different times, and different likes and dislikes too.</p>	<p>KS1 1.3.2 Feeling Inside Out</p> <p>Children will take part in activities to help them understand and articulate their own feelings and how other people's feelings might differ from theirs.</p>
