Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you all enjoyed the half term break and are looking forward to one of the most exciting terms in the school year – Christmas! We have lots to look forward to: the Spiegeltent, Advent service and the Nativity.

This term in our Topic lessons, we will be exploring the question: 'how did boats help to discover the world?' We will also learn about the lives of famous explorers: Christopher Columbus and John Cabot. As Bristol is a city rich in naval history we will be visiting the docks to see the all the different boats we have in our city. The children will also be practising simple map-making skills, helping them to understand direction, landmarks, and the features of their community. Forest School

The children will be doing forest school **every Monday** for the remainder of the term. Please ensure your child has a coat, waterproofs (if possible) and wellies. We try to get outside in all weathers (unless it's unsafe) so please ensure your child has appropriate clothing. Forest school is a fantastic opportunity for the children and one we are extremely fortunate to be able to offer. To ensure the children get the most out of the experience they must be in the correct clothing.

Communication

Uniform

Please ensure your child is wearing full school uniform on a Monday, Thursday and Friday and that each item is clearly labelled.

PE

PE sessions will take place on **Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons**. In line with school policy, the children are expected to come to school on these days wearing their PE kits. Their kit should consist of: a white polo, black joggers and black daps. I would particularly ask where possible that girls come to school on PE days wearing PE trousers and socks (not tights) – it would be incredibly helpful.
