Please remember that Celebration Assembly will continue to take place every Monday morning at 9:05am. Classes will present topic based Assemblies on Friday mornings at 9:05am (running order attached). You are very welcome to join us at these special events. Thank you.

Stay and Read/Count sessions:

Please join your child in their class room to share a book or a Mathematics challenge from 8:40am every Thursday. This week will be stay and read.

Toys:

Unfortunately we have had to ban Pokémon cards in school this afternoon as they were causing upset between pupils. Please can we remind you that toys are not allowed in school, this rule has not changed.

Injuries at school:

If your child has an injury at school and we are unable to get hold of you and your emergency contact it may be necessary for school staff to take your child for treatment. Please, therefore, make sure that we have the correct contact details for you and all carers.

Attendance and Punctuality:

Our attendance target for this academic year is 96.1%. Our current figure is 97.30%. Thank you to those who attend regularly. Please remember to phone the school office if your child is going to be absent. If we do not hear from you, we will ring you and then may also make a home visit if we are unable to contact you.

This week 14 children were late to school. Thank you to those who arrive on time. Remember, children can go straight to class from 8:45am or attend breakfast club from 8am if necessary. If we receive pupil premium funding for your child then breakfast club is free.

On Wednesday 18th October, we will be holding a parent's information evening on attendance. This is a chance to discuss the policy and make sure everyone understand the procedures. From September we have been asked by the local authority to issue penalty notice fines when a child is absent for more than 4 days within a 10 week period.
